ARTICLE VIII

Scholarship Fund

Section 1. The Scholarship Fund Committee shall receive and solicit all funds, and, from time to time, it shall use appropriate means to create additional funds when it is deemed necessary to establish more money for the ensuing year's budget.

ARTICLE IX

Method of Expenditure of Scholarship Fund

Section 1. All applications for the Student Fund shall be made directly to the Chairman of the Scholarship Fund Committee.

Section 2. Any graduate of Amache High School receiving an acceptance to a College in the United States shall be eligible to apply for the Scholarship Fund.

Section 3. Each applicant's background shall be checked for age and citizenship and character.

Section 4. When final determination is made as to eligibility for the Scholarship Fund, the applicant shall be notified that his application has been accepted, and that a specified amount will be allocated in the fund to be given to him after he has been officially registered in his College.

Section 5. The check made out to the student shall be mailed in care of the Registrar of the College of the student's choice, with instruction that it be given to the student upon registration.

Section 6. Exception to Section 5 may be made upon determination by the Scholarship Fund Committee.

We the Community Council and the Block Managers Assembly of the Granada Relocation Center in joint meeting representing the resident as a whole, hereby do make known the adoption of the following resolutions by unanimous vote:

Be it resolved,

That we express our appreciation to you, Dillon S. Myer, Director of W.R.A., for your understanding of the various problems that confront us and your earnest efforts to aid us,

We appreciate your understanding, as shown by your recent decision to give equal rights to Issei in our Community Government which was requested of you at your previous visit. This, we believe, is an expression of the democratic principles governing the W.R.A.,

We appreciate your untiring efforts in clarifying and correcting the numerous inaccurate reports by various political groups who seem to be maliciously intent on creating an adverse atmosphere about us without realizing that we are the victims of circumstances,

We also appreciate your efforts in conveying correct information to the public and your appeal to them in our behalf through various mediums including the press and the radio broadcasts.
