

RECORD LIST

The following list of records has been compiled by Mr. Jackson for the benefit of English and Social Studies teachers in correlating a music program with their units of study. The list is divided into two sections: the first section lists records by title, and the second section by composer.

The names, Bernhart, Dumas, McGovern, Walther, Jackson, and school indicate who possesses that particular record or set. All records, except those belonging to the school, will be checked through Mr. Jackson. He should be notified a day in advance in order that he can obtain the record you wish. School records are divided into two groups: spoken recordings such as the Americans All set may be checked from the main office; music records may be checked from the music department, either from Mr. Hinman or Mr. Jackson.
