The Office of Institutional Research is pleased to announce its new web site at <http://www.coloradocollege.edu/dean/oir>. The site contains the updated 2000-01 Statistical Profile, the Common Data Set, Data Resources and Survey Data available through the Office of Institutional Research, & Web links to external institutional research pages.

As you know, the Statistical Profile is a compilation of data published by the IR Office to meet the **internal needs** of the college. Traditionally, the Profile was published and hard copies were distributed to the campus community, but now the Profile will be more readily accessible on the Web and will be continually updated to assure that the current information you need is always available. In order to access the complete version, go to the Faculty/Administrators/Staff Access icon and enter your Windows password and domain name within the password box. The Profile is broken down into 6 categories, (General Information; Organization Charts; Admissions/Registrar/Financial Aid; Student Life; Campus Resources; Faculty/Administrators/Staff; & Financial/Business) with a table of contents within each category to assist you in finding the information you need. Currently, we are having problems with the password access through Netscape, so it is advised that you use Internet Explorer until these difficulties have been resolved.

Upon request, the Office of Institutional Research has also placed the Common Data Set on the Web, which is a compilation of data created by publishers and data providers in the higher education community to meet the **external needs** of the college through standard reporting.

Please use the data within these pages with care. Depending upon the definitions of the survey you are using, the data within these tables may or may not be the correct numbers that you need. As any statistician will tell you, seemingly simple questions usually have multiple answers, all dependent upon how you are counting what you are counting.
